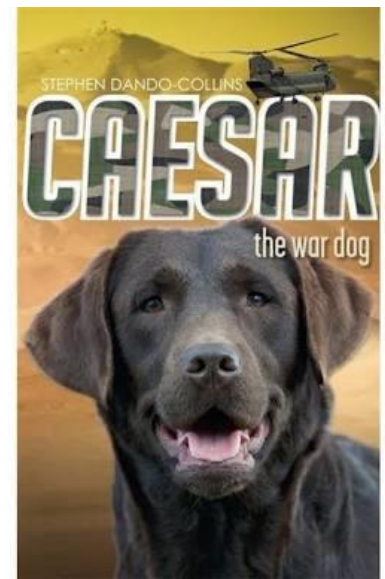


Book review
