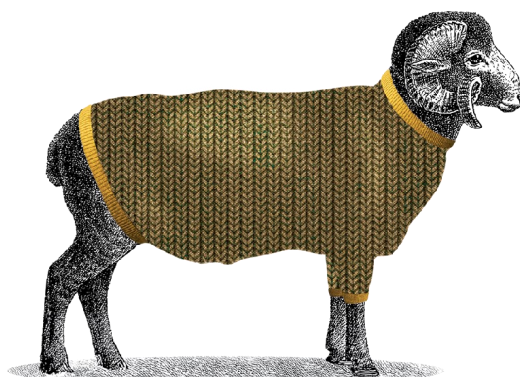


Education and Toys
