
Learning at school or at home, we did it together!

At school and home, the learning has included the importance of hygiene and remembering to wash their hands regularly throughout the day.

Also included are retelling stories, correctly forming letters, skip counting, measuring objects, ordinal numbers, odd and even numbers and using the Zones of Regulation to understand their own emotions.







Over the past few weeks in 1/2N and 2/3P, students have been learning about 2D and 3D objects. During week 4, students at home and at school have been working to design and construct a 3D castle.

They created a 3D brain and also learnt how our Zones of Regulation tool kit can help our brain to make good choices and prevent the "lid from flipping".

















It has been hard not being able to meet with our beautiful families for such a long time. But do not despair! We can still stay connected!






The Seesaw app is a good way for you and your children to share with us and also a quick way to contact me.
