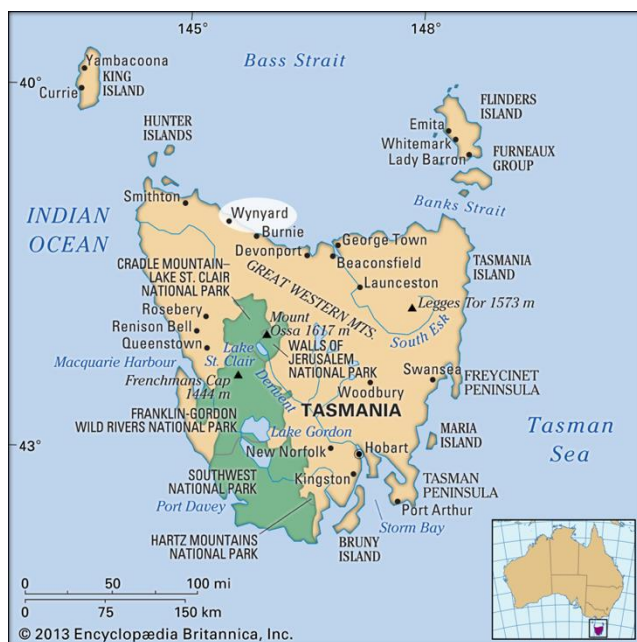


Wynyard...
