

# Kingston

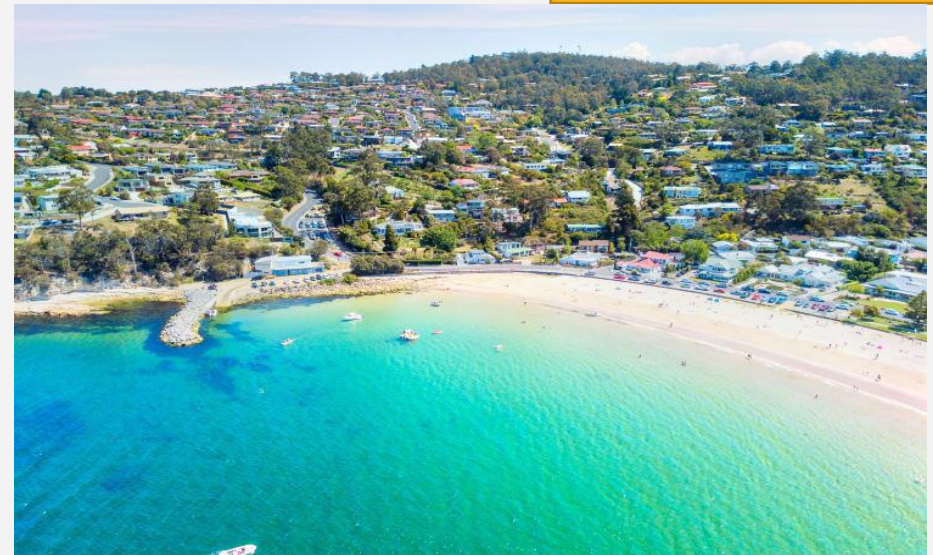
1. In 1804, the botanist Robert Brown visited the area. Brown's River, that runs from mount Wellington to Kingston Beach is named after him

2. The area was settled in 1808 by Thomas Lucas, Sophie Lucas and his family, who were evacuated from Norfolk Island,

3. Kingston was proclaimed a township in 1851

4. The population of Kingston is 10,409

5. The headquarters of the Australian Antarctic Division is in Kingston. Sir Douglas Mawson's sled is on display as well as photographs and his own things from Antarctica
