**JUNIOR VOCAL ENSEMBLE** is for students in Grades 4 - 6/7, and in 2022 will meet for rehearsal at Reece High School on Tuesday afternoons between 3.30 and 4.30 pm, under the direction of Ms Carine Kruger and Ms Dominique Baker. There are performance opportunities throughout the year, and the programme includes tuition in vocal and ensemble singing technique.

**JUNIOR INSTRUMENTAL ENSEMBLE** is for students in Grades 4 - 6/7, and in 2022 will meet for rehearsal at Reece High School on Wednesday afternoons between 3.30 and 4.30 pm, under the direction of Ms Dominique Baker, Ms Carine Kruger and Mr Tom McGee. Tuition is provided primarily in woodwind (flute, clarinet, saxophone) and brass (trumpet, trombone, baritone) instruments, with limited places for students of drums and bass guitar. The programme provides small-group tuition and ensemble (band) rehearsal and performance opportunities.
