

Devon Netball Association Winter Roster 2022

Your child has expressed an interest in participating in the Devon Netball Association Primary Winter Roster which will commence on <u>Saturday March 19</u>, with breaks for the school holidays and long weekends. All games are played at the Spreyton Netball Centre. Primary Netball is open to any girls or boys turning 8 or older in 2022 and at primary school with modified rules for those aged 10 and under.

Please return the attached permission slip to your school netball co-ordinator.

Registration

Registrations need to be paid in full before taking the court on Saturday March 19, so that players are covered by Insurance. This year registration must completed online, you will find a "REGISTER NOW" button @ www.devonnetball.com.au. The office will be open on the first day of the roster if you have trouble registering and someone will be able to help you. Costs: Devon Netball Primary Roster Fee is \$50. Netball Tasmania annual fee is \$53.87 and covers you for the year (so total cost for this roster will be \$103.87). Devon Netball Netta Roster Fee is \$30. Netball Australia Annual Fee is \$83.05 and covers you for the year and includes a NetSetGo pack (so a total costs of \$113.05). Ticket to Play Vouchers can be used as a payment option.

Duty

Duty responsibilities are shared by everyone. Our games need to start promptly, so we encourage players to arrive early to complete duties, warm up and be ready to take to the court on time. All Primary matches will be centrally timed along with Secondary matches. Games will take place at 8.45am or 10.00am (Netta games will still be individually timed).

- Teams are required to collect equipment from outside the club rooms and set up their courts.
- Netta teams need to time their own games 4 x 10 minute guarters with a two minute break between guarters.
- All teams playing the last game on that court are required to pack up the court and return equipment.
- A canteen roster for parents will be drawn up once the draw is completed. Please ensure that you have someone rostered to do this duty when your school is named.

Umpires/Coaches

It is in your team's best interest to have a Coach and a separate umpire. This will allow your coach to provide coaching without the worry of umpiring. Devon will have a pool of junior developing umpires, if your team would like to arrange game payments for these umpires we can arrange season or weekly umpires with advanced notice. Umpire fee is \$10 per week.

Uniforms

Players are required to be in their school's uniform, have short fingernails and wear no jewellery or sharp hair clips. **Taping of jewellery is not permitted**, if children are not prepared to remove piercings and jewellery they will not be allowed to play.

Cancellations

Primary netball is cancelled when it is deemed that the weather is too wet. There will be no catch up games if any cancellations occur. Cancellation notices will be posted on www.devon.tas.netball.com.au and Facebook.

Scoring

Primary netball focuses on skill development, participation and enjoyment.

- All Grade 5/6 games will be scored. No scores will be kept for Netta.
- Each team is to provide a scorer, both scorers are to sit together in allocated seating.
- All score cards must be brought to the office, by the umpire or official of the winning team.
- No Finals will be played, a ladder will be kept, the team finishing on top of the ladder will receive medals.
- Rotation of players is strongly recommended in Grade 5/6 games and must be strictly adhered to in Netta.
- No player should have more than one quarter off the court unless injured or ill.
- If a school does not have sufficient players for a match, the opposing team should lend them a player (or two) if they are available.
